



OPGC – Bordas and Bordas 3 Man Mix Tournament – Crispin Center

Sunday, August 9, 2026 - 8:30 Shotgun Start
Prizes and Lunch at Camp Russell following play



White tees - default, players age **70+** - **Gold Tees**, Age **80+** - **Red Tees**, players with index 4.0 or lower move back one tee.

Team Target Handicap is 30 using each player's **iCap** Index listed on the OPGC website.

- Based on your team's iCap total, your team handicap will be adjusted based on the target of 30.
- If your team handicap is under 30, your team will give 1 stroke back for every 2 points under 30.
- If your team handicap is over 30, your team will get 1 stroke for every 2 points over 30.

Scoring:

Each 3-man team will play 1 ball consisting of a 2-man scramble, while the 3rd player plays his own ball. 2 separate scores are recorded per hole, 1 individual score next to the player's name, and 1 scramble score. The 2-man team scrambling and the individual player rotates every 6 holes.

The 6 hole rotation is based on holes 1-6, 7-12, and 13-18 regardless of what hole you start on.

For example, if you start on hole 6, the person playing his own ball on 6 would then scramble on hole 7.

Players are permitted to move the ball 12 inches, no closer to the hole, except within penalty areas.

1. You are permitted to "bump with the club" instead of formal "lift, clean, and place"
2. Ball in sand trap may be lifted to rake (foot rake) trap - place ball back in original spot
3. All roads and white stake areas are out of bounds: (2 options)
 - a. Re-tee, 1 stroke penalty
 - b. Alternate OB rule - move to fairway where ball went out, 2 stroke penalty
